

# Community Empowerment for Creative Innovation secured 5 year funding from the Mastercard Foundation through War Child Canada.

#### "THE BRIDGE"

The project supports Accelerated Education Programme known as AEP. This Programme is divided into 2 levels and it targets drop outs of P.7 (should have sat PLE 2 years back), S1, S2, S3, S4 (never sat UCE or sat but failed), S5, S6 (never sat).

### Level 1 targets

• P.7, S1 and S2 (they will cover S1 and S2 syllabus coverage in 1 year and they will sit transition exams to progress to level 2).

#### Level 2 targets

• S3, S4, S5, S6 (they will cover S3 and S4 syllabus in 1 year and they will sit UCE examined by UNEB which will transit them to Advanced level of Education or BTVET).

4 years per level.
Year 2 (2024)
- Level 1 enroll 75 learners
- Level 2 enroll 75 learners
Year 4 (2026)
- Level 1 enroll 75 learners
- Level 2 enroll 75 learners
Year 5 (2027)
No new enrolment as the learners of year 4
will be completing.

#### **AEP Centers**

2 secondary schools in refugee hosting locations (District/Sub Counties)

- Padrombu SS in Lobule Sub County
- Millennium College SS in Kuluba Sub County.

## Procedure for enrolment

- A learner must have completed PLE before 2020 (2 years back)
- Learner must be 15 years to 35 years (youth)
- Proof of completion of primary education (PLE result slip)
- Nationals will present a national ID or a letter from LC 1 (both are necessary)
- Refugees will present an attestation card of Refugee ID

NOTE: All AEP schools will start on 6<sup>th</sup> February 2023. Interested children should visit the mentioned schools with the required documents for enrolment. This is a 100% scholarship for the categories listed.
